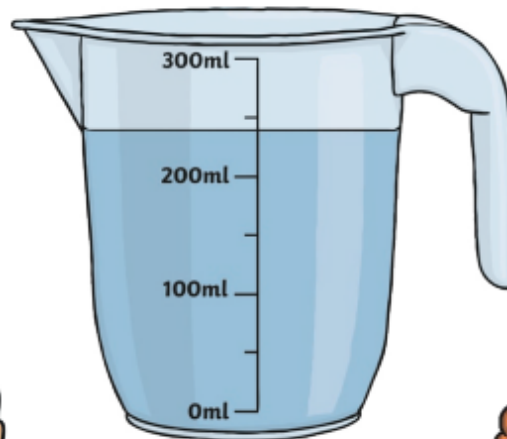


Maths—this week we have been looking at capacity.
