Frequently Asked Questions

	Question	Answer
1	When will the change take place and how will it impact children who are currently at Carr Manor Community School?	It is proposed that Carr Manor Community School will have an offer of education for 2-19 year olds. If the proposal is agreed, an increase of 24 2-4 year olds would take place in September 2024. Applications for a Nursery place will be to school.
2	Will the admissions criteria change for Carr Manor Community School when it has a 2-4-year-old provision?	The current admissions criteria for Reception and Year 7 will not change if Carr Manor Community School increases its age range.
3	What hours will the places be available?	We will confirm hours based on the regular working of the school and the outcomes of the consultation.
4	How will lunch times and outdoor play be managed with 2-4 year olds in school?	The outdoor space at the side of the EYFS unit and KS1 will be redesigned to allow an Early Years playground, thus creating more room for free flow for the Early Years. Children will have their lunch within the unit and then move into the Early Years outdoor area.
5	Is there a car park nearby parents could use to park at transition times and can that be accessed?	There is a car park on the Primary Phase site that parents can access. The school maintains a travel plan.
6	How are the changes to the building being funded?	The project is being funded through the school's budget.
